

Register for universal infant free school meals now!

From September, all pupils in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 will be able to receive a school meal at no cost to the parent or guardian*. School meals in Enfield are healthy, tasty, social and fun and from September 2014 choosing a school lunch for your child/children will help save you up approximately £400 per year if you take up the offer.

In Enfield we anticipate that this will be a popular offer with parents and children. If you have a child who will be in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 in September 2014, please complete the short form overleaf and return to your child's school as soon as possible.

Quality food, every day...

The majority of meals in Enfield primary schools are provided by Enfield Catering Services. The Service has been awarded the prestigious Soil Association's Bronze Catering Mark, and has committed to the following:

- Our meals are freshly cooked on site by our qualified staff
- Many of our fruit and vegetables are seasonal and locally produced, and our eggs are free-range
- Our meat comes from a butcher and meets UK animal welfare standards and our fish is Marine Stewardship Council (MSC) certified
- Our menus meet the Government's Nutrition standards and is a quality alternative to a packed lunch
- We have regular tasting events, and theme days to fit in with popular occasions and the National Curriculum

Meat and vegetarian options are available every day, and we can cater for children who have other dietary requirements where a menu is agreed in advance. This can include religious, cultural or allergy and/or intolerance diets. Forms and further information will be available from your child's school office once your form is returned. Can my child still bring a packed lunch?

Yes they can, but we would encourage them to try a school lunch. This will give them a varied and balanced diet and save you time and money. Even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal, we would encourage you to complete the form so that your child's school receives as much funding as possible. Although you do not have to provide your national insurance number(s), it is really important that you complete all the information asked for in this form as this will help us to see if your child's school is entitled to claim additional grant money called the 'Pupil Premium'.

To help us plan for the increase in children having a school lunch from September 2014, and ensure that your child's school receives as much funding possible, please provide the details requested on the short form overleaf and return to your child's school.

*NB. A cash alternative is not available for those pupils not taking a school lunch from September 2014.
