

Curriculum Overview - Year 1 - Summer 1 Term

Subject Area	Content
English	<p>During our English lessons, we will be looking into different aspects of grammar and using those in our own writing. These will include basic sentence rules, connectives, adjectives, prefixes and suffixes.</p> <p>We will be looking at different types of writing including instructions, letters, recounts and stories.</p> <p>In Phonics, we will be working with all 44 sounds in the English language and their alternative spellings. We will be reading words with these sounds as well as writing words with them.</p> <p>In handwriting, we will carry on practicing lowercase and capital letters and applying this to all our areas of learning.</p>
Maths	<p>In Summer term, we will be reinforcing our number fluency as well as other aspects of the curriculum. We will focus on the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number bonds to 20. • Addition and subtraction • Using different Mathematical strategies when solving number sentences. • Half and quarter of shapes and numbers. • Being familiar with numbers up to 100. • Place value. • Length, mass and volume. • Time. • Money. <p>We will also continue developing our understanding in measurement, time and shape as well as problem solving.</p>
Art	This term we will be learning how to show movement from a still drawing.
PE	PE is with a specialist teacher; the children are learning basketball skills.
PSHE	In PSHE, our topic this half-term is 'Relationships'.
RE	We will be learning about special books.
Science	We will be learning about living things and classifying animals and plants.
Geography	In Geography we will be learning about locations.
History	We will be learning about the past and present Royal Family.
