

**Confirmed case of COVID-19 in the school- Woodpecker Hall Academy**

**Closing 4W**

14<sup>th</sup> December 2020

Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been advised by Public Health England that there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the school.

As your child has been in close contact with the infected individual, in line with national guidance, your child must now **stay at home and self-isolate** until **Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> December**. Your child can go about their normal daily life from **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> December**.

If your child is well at the end of the 10-day period of self-isolation, then they can return to usual activities. Other members of your household can continue their normal activities provided your child does not develop symptoms within the 10-day self-isolation period.

**What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19**

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, they should remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. All other household members who remain well must stay at home and not leave the house for 10 days.

The 10-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill.

Household members should not go to work, school or public areas. Household members staying at home for 10 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection that they can pass on to others in the community.

If you are able, isolate from vulnerable individuals (such as the elderly and those with underlying health conditions) living in your home, please do so during your isolation period.

**Symptoms of COVID 19**

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- New continuous cough and/or
- High temperature
- Loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

### Home Learning

For the next 3 days your child's teacher will be supporting your child to access online learning. Your child is expected to continue to learn from home every day until Friday as school is closed on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December.

Your child's learning will be posted onto DB primary daily. The class teacher will be monitoring the work online and will get in touch with your child by phone or Zoom at least twice a week for a progress catch up. Please see the attached timetable for home-learning.
