Dear parent/carer,

I am writing to let you know that over the next couple of weeks your child will be constructing musical instruments from unwanted items and materials as part of his/her year 2 music learning.

The lesson will reinforce the ideas that they've been exploring as part of their 'Reduce, Reuse, Recycle' learning journey, and will help them to develop an appreciation for how anything can potentially be transformed into a musical instrument.

With this in mind, I'm asking parents to keep hold of any items that could be used in this lesson, including:

- Egg boxes
- Kitchen towel holder
- Bottle tops
- Tissue or ice-cream boxes
- Pringles tubes
- Plastic bottles
- Cardboard (e.g. cereal boxes)
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We're asking that these items be as clean as possible and that you bring them at least 3 days before the lesson to allow them to be sanitised and then left before using again, in compliance with COVID restrictions.

This means that your child's item would have to be brought into school by **Monday 10th May**.

School will be providing some of the materials but the more the merrier!

I can't wait to see what our children put together.
