# **Late Drop Off**

We had a large number of parents who dropped off their children late this morning. This means that children have to come through the office and be signed in by the office team.

Unfortunately, a couple of parents felt that it was ok to shout at the staff this morning and demanded that the children are just "let through". Firstly, this is not possible and secondly this behaviour is not acceptable and will not be tolerated.

The school gates are open from 8:45 to 8:55am for children in Reception to year 6. All children should be in school before the gates close. If you arrive after 8:55am you must bring your child to the school office. Here we will take your child's name and ask parents why the child is late. After this has happened the child can go to their classroom. I understand that from time to time you may be late due to traffic or other unforeseen circumstances. However, in a Primary School, it is the parent's responsibility to get the children into school on time.

### Covid-19 Guidance

There seems to be some confusion around the guidance for self-isolating. Parents, who have tested positive, have received an NHS text to state that everyone in the household needs to isolate due to one positive Covid-19 case. I have looked at some of the texts that have been sent from the NHS and they are a little unclear so I contacted Public Health Enfield today for clarification.

If someone in your household has tested positive for Covid-19 the rest of the household are strongly advised:





- If you are double jabbed and have no symptoms take an LFT for 7 days. So long as the results are negative you **DO NOT** need to self-isolate.
- If you are a child under, under the age of 18 years and 6 months, you need take an LFT for 7 days. So long as the results are negative you **DO NOT** need to self-isolate.
- If you are an adult and you are not double jabbed, and you live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, you are legally required to stay at home and self-isolate.
