<b>Nursery &amp; Reception</b>	Spain – red and yellow
<b>Year 1 &amp; 2</b>	Argentina – blue, white and yellow
<b>Year 3</b>	Mexico – red, white and green
<b>Year 4</b>	Equatorial Guinea – green, white, red and blue
<b>Year 5</b>	Cuba – red, white and blue
<b>Year 6</b>	Colombia – red, blue and yellow

There will also be a **special menu** prepared by the catering team, inspired by the traditional cuisine of Spain.

After the success of our last event in 2023, we are thrilled to be bringing Hispanic Culture Day back to Woodpecker Hall this academic year and we hope our students are as well.
