Understanding the World

This half term, we will explore cold places worldwide using globes and Google Earth, focusing on the Arctic and Antarctic. We'll compare local winter weather and clothing to these regions and discuss winter animals and their adaptations. Children will also attend weekly forest garden sessions, emphasizing health and sustainability, including hygiene practices and homelessness, while linking human and physical features of winter to our prior learning on travel and transport.
