Reception trip - RAF Museum

Dear Parent/Carers,

As part of our Learning Journey next half term 'Amazing People', we will be taking the children to visit the Royal Air Force (RAF) Museum.

They will spend the day learning and exploring the different transport vehicles e.g. aeroplanes & jets used in the past and making links to one of the Amazing People they will be learning about – Amelia Earhart. The children will take part in a workshop called 'Teddy's Travels' which will make the visit engaging and challenge the children to follow clues to fine the 'lost medal'.

Details are as follows:

Place: <u>Grahame Park Way, London NW</u>9 5LL

Travel: School minibus

Cost: A contribution of **£4 per pupil** is needed to cover the cost of the Workshop 'Teddy

Travels' which the children will take part in on the day. In the event there are not

enough contributions the trip may have to be cancelled.

The children need to **wear school uniform**, comfortable walking shoes e.g. trainers/school shoes and a **jacket** with a hood is advised in the event of rainy weather.

School packed lunch is available to all Reception Pupils e.g. sandwich, drink, piece of fruit and crisps. Please let your child's class teacher know if you would like us to provide a lunch or if your child will be bringing their own from home. Please note: Nuts/Fish are not allowed.

Please ensure you sign into **Arbor to give permission and to make the payment** for the trip.

We would like to make you aware if your child is absent from school on the day a refund may not be possible as we must book in advance.
