Dear Parent/ Carers,

In Spring term, the children in Year 2 will be learning about Kings and Queens. To support their learning about Queen Victoria and the Victorian period, the children will have the opportunity to participate in an exciting, hands-on workshop provided by Freshwater Theatre Company.

During the workshop, the year 2 classrooms will be transported back to 1899 to give the children a lesson they won't forget by a Victorian teacher. Children will experience different aspects of the Victorian curriculum including handwriting, spelling and times tables and get a real-life opportunity to explore what it was like to be a Victorian child.

We encourage the children to dress as a Victorian pupil to become fully immersed in the experience. Children must come to school dressed as a Victorian child on the day below.
