Maths

Multiplication and Division



- -Identify multiples and factors

Genre: Fiction - Flashback/alternative perspectives



Children learn to be story tellers! They will learn how to build on from other characters and will be adding in their own locations to the story to enhance excitement and how this changes the story and improves fluidity. They will also be looking at how to include alternative perspectives of characters and will explore how this changes the feel, atmosphere and mood of the story.

Skill children will be focusing on areas:

Expanded noun phrases, relative clauses, modal verbs, parenthesis (brackets, dashes and commas), adverbial phrases including fronted adverbials and descriptive language (similes/metaphors)

Handwriting – children to continue to work on cursive letter joining Spelling - children to continue to work on the spelling patterns; 'ation' and 'sc', to build on knowledge of homophones, and to investigate how to spell tricker words.


