As part of our Geography learning this half term, we are excited to be taking all Year 6 classes on a local fieldwork trip to Gunpowder Park in the Lee Valley. This visit will support our enquiry-led Geography unit, 'What's so special about the Galápagos Islands?', by helping the children practise key fieldwork skills such as map reading, data collection and observing physical and human features in the environment.

During the visit, pupils will carry out hands-on investigations designed to reflect the geographical processes and themes we have studied in class, including biodiversity, land use, conservation and the impact of humans on natural spaces.
