



Ofsted Visit

This academic year Ofsted changed the framework in which it inspects schools. This new framework will roll out in November for all schools.

Our next inspection is likely to be in 2027-2028. However, we were asked by the Local Authority to support Ofsted in trialling the new framework. We have agreed to this as it's always good to get expert feedback on what we are doing well and what we can do even better.

Consequently, the school will have a full 2-day inspection on **Tuesday 14**th **and Wednesday 15**th **October**. This doesn't change our grading and we won't get a report but we do get expert advice from the team that will be with us.

School Food Menus

As you know the school changed its menu in September. This was to ensure that we comply with all national health and food requirements. We have finished the first cycle of the new menus and have taken feedback from the children. This feedback has been handed to the Manager of the Trust Kitchens and further changes are being made to menu.

Children will be invited in the coming weeks to take part in tasting sessions where they can vote on their favourite additions to the menus.
