Inspiring Awe and Wonder:



Children will bring their favourite toy to school. They will watch a video of and re-enact the moon landing.

Maths



This term the children will be exploring number bonds to 10 and solving one step problems that involve both addition and subtraction of 1- and 2-digit numbers. Whilst learning about time, children will sequence events, recognise language relating to days of the week. They will learn to tell the time to the hour, recognising the hour hand and say o'clock.

English



In English this term, the children will be reading Traction Man by Mimi Grey. They will orally retell the story whilst creating their own mission for Traction Man ensuring they are using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. The children will also learn to write a report on a mysterious event in school to read to Miss Ross.

Music



This term, the children will explore using a glockenspiel, learn Christmas songs and perform a mini concert.

PHSE & P4C: Celebrating Differences



Children will be exploring the similarities and differences between themselves and their friends. They will learn to celebrate their differences. They will also learn about the importance of friendship and what to do if they see someone being unkind.

Spanish



This term, the children will revisit counting to 10 and learning to name different parts of the body. They will also be learning about Christmas traditions in Spain.

Physical Education



Health & Wellbeing

(Agility, Balance, Co -ordination) — Children will focus on developing agility, balance, and coordination. They'll learn why these skills are important and apply them through fun activities and challenges, ending with an athletics festival to showcase their progress.

Gymnastics (Body Parts) - Children will explore different movements and balances using both big and small parts of their bodies, on the floor and on apparatus. They'll learn to combine shapes like wide, narrow, and curled, and create mini sequences to develop their coordination, control, and creativity.

Computing: What is technology?



This term the children will explore different tools on the computer to design and create their own pictures. They will evaluate their pictures and compare painting a picture on a computer to painting on paper.

The Nativity



This term the children will be rehearing their lines, songs and dances to perform loudly and clearly to an audience of both KS1 and parents.

History: The Space Race and Toys from The Past and Present



The children will explore toys from the past and present and discuss how they have changed over time. Whilst investigating the past, they will learn about the Space Race and the significance of Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin.

RE: Christianity



The children will learn about Christianity and the story of Christmas. Through their lessons, they will discuss the meaning and significance of giving gifts and answer the question: What gifts might Christians, in my town, have given Jesus if he had been born here rather than in Bethlehem?
