As part of our Learning Journey in the next half term 'World War 2', we will be taking the children to the Imperial War Museum London

During their visit to the Imperial War Museum London, the children will have the opportunity to explore a range of powerful galleries and objects from different conflicts and time periods and through self-discovery will investigate how people's experiences of war have been recorded and remembered through photographs, posters, letters and personal stories.

Our aim is to ensure these hands-on activities encourage curiosity, empathy and critical thinking, helping the children to understand how museums help us learn from the past and reflect on the impact of conflict on individuals and communities.
