Geometry and measurement

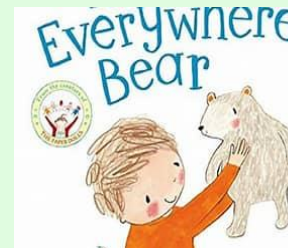
- Properties of 2D shapes

Character description - Narrative – Poster

- Description of the Everywhere Bear from the book 'Everywhere Bear' By Julia Donaldson.
- Focus on adjectives, nouns, verbs and conjunctions (and, but, because)
- Focus on expanded noun phrases.
- **Spelling** – Red words set 1, 2, 3 and 4
- **Handwriting** – Continuous cursive handwriting
- **Guided reading** – daily sessions focusing on reading skills

Outdoor – Locomotion: Dodging

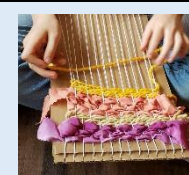
